Wireless Hotspot Access for Mac Users

Setup Wireless Networking (Mac OS X 10.2)

Mac OS X 10.2 and higher users can connect to the Yarra Plenty Library WiFi network from a Macintosh computer with an Airport card.

To setup wireless networking in Mac OS X 10.2:

1. Open **System Preferences** from the dock



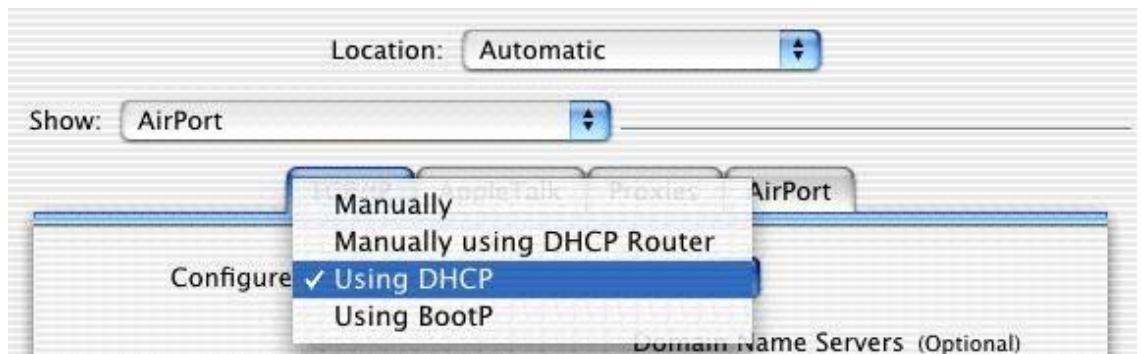
2. Within System Preferences, select **Network**.



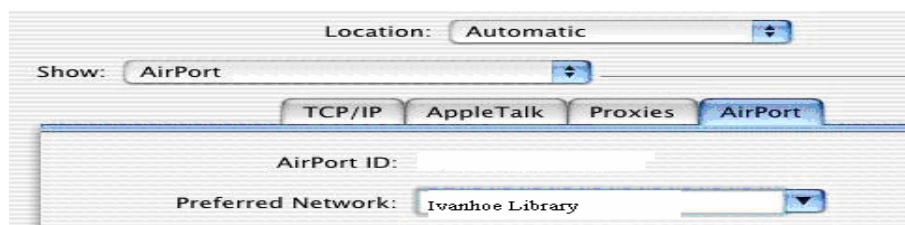
3. Set **Location** to **Automatic** and set **Show** to **AirPort**. If you are unable to select AirPort, select Active Network Ports and make sure AirPort is selected.



4. Under the **TCP/IP** tab, set **Configure** to **Using DHCP**.



5. Under the **Airport** tab, select **the Yarra Plenty Library Branch you are accessing the WiFi network at** from the dropdown preferred network list.
If the list of Yarra Plenty Libraries does not show up, you are either out of range from the wireless network, or have not enabled your airport interface (step 3 above).



Close System Preferences, saving any changes you made. You are now ready to access the Yarra Plenty WiFi network in your selected branch!
