### Yarra Plenty Regional Library's New Festival invites Busy Booklovers to Indulge

Yarra Plenty Regional Library's inaugural Booklovers Festival to be held from Monday 27 July to Thursday 30 July heralds the arrival of an innovative book program that meets the needs of the modern reader.

Well-known and lauded authors Arnold Zable, Jacinta Halloran, Kate Holden, James Phelan, Greg De Moore and Bette Shiels are set to speak at the festival, leading the conversation about books at six separate events across the library service.

The bedside reads program involves regular chats about books at all the Yarra Plenty Regional Library branches, where booklovers are invited to attend to chat about what books they are reading or are currently on their bedside table.

YPRL Reading and Literacy Coordinator Kerri Pleydell-Sander points out that bedside reads is perfect for busy readers who love books but don't have time to read a book a month for a book club. Booklovers can get together to talk about books, meet other like-minded people and get ideas about what to read next.

The Booklovers Festival has been designed to appeal to all booklovers. The diverse authors appearing at the events have written interesting autobiography, contemporary fiction, thrillers, historical biography and paranormal fiction. There will also be an opportunity to buy the authors' books and have them signed.

- **Award-winning author Arnold Zable chats about his new book *Sea of Many Returns*, which takes us to the Greek isle Ithaca, and his reading choices at Lalor Library on Tuesday 28 July between 7.00pm and 8.00pm.**
- **This year's Jack Pollard prize-winner Greg de Moore chats about his historical biography about Tom Wills, founder of Aussie Rules, at Eltham Library on Tuesday 28 July between 7.00 and 8.30pm.**

- **Author Kate Holden will talk about her extraordinary journey through an often hidden world of heroin and prostitution depicted in her autobiography *In My Skin* at Diamond Valley Library on Wednesday 29 July between 7.00pm and 8.00pm.**
- **Thriller writer James Phelan talks about his novel *Fox Hunt* and his reading tastes at Watsonia Library on Thursday 30 July from 7.00pm to 8.00pm.**
